PRIMOUS FOUNTAIN, the extraordinarily gifted, self-taught composer was raised in Ida B. Wells Housing Project in Chicago. He began his career during his first year at Wendell Phillips High School.

Quincy Jones, the internationally renowned producer, composer and impresario, was one of the first to recognize the potential of this composer before any of Fountain's works were performed. Jones immediately became Fountain's patron and mentor.

Soon after Primous completed high school the Chicago Symphony Orchestra premièred 'Manifestation'.

Arthur Mitchell later choreographed a ballet to 'Manifestation' for his *Dance Theatre of Harlem*, which become the company's signature ballet.

Fountain was the youngest person ever to have received a Guggenheim Fellowship. A second Guggenheim followed two years later.

His music has been performed by many of the major orchestras including the San Francisco, Milwaukee, Buffalo, Minnesota and Detroit Symphonies.
